SIA Engineering Company signs MOU for Vietnam joint venture

• The joint venture in Vietnam will be SIA Engineering Company's fifth line maintenance initiative outside Singapore

SINGAPORE, 2 November 2007 - Mainboard-listed **SIA Engineering Company Limited** has signed a Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) with Saigon Ground Services (SAGS), a division of the Southern Airport Authorities, to form a line maintenance joint venture at Tan Son Nhat International Airport in Ho Chi Minh City, Vietnam.

Under the MOU, SIA Engineering Company shall hold a 49% equity shareholding in the joint venture, with the remaining 51% owned by SAGS.

The joint venture shall provide line maintenance aircraft certifications to airlines at Tan Son Nhat International Airport. Subject to viability, the joint venture would expand its presence to other airports in Vietnam and widen its service offerings at a later stage to include light and heavy maintenance checks, as well as component overhaul services.

SIA Engineering Company's Chief Executive Officer, Mr William Tan said: "We are delighted to partner Saigon Ground Services, which offers airport ground services to a wide customer base at Tan Son Nhat International Airport. Tapping on our engineering expertise, the joint venture will provide aircraft certifications and deliver a high level of despatch reliability to international airlines at Ho Chi Minh City."

"This is our fifth overseas line maintenance joint venture. The initiative will strengthen our line maintenance network in the Asia-Pacific region, which currently covers more than 40 airports in Singapore, Australia, China, Indonesia and the Philippines", Mr Tan added.

Mr Nguyen Dinh Hung, Director of SAGS, said: "This line maintenance joint venture with SIA Engineering Company is SAGS' first joint venture at Tan Son Nhat International Airport, which paves the way for the enhancement of services provided at the airport. The joint venture will set new line maintenance standards not only at the airport but also in Vietnam, leading to the overall success of Vietnam's aviation industry."

Both parties will proceed to work out the details of the definitive agreement for the transaction.

The transaction is not expected to have a material impact on the Company's financial performance in FY2007/08. None of the Directors of the Company has any interest, direct or indirect, in the transaction.
