



SIA Engineering Company Celebrates Official Opening of Base Maintenance Malaysia in Subang

Subang, Malaysia, 22 May 2026 — SIA Engineering Company Limited (“SIAEC”) will, today, mark the official opening of Base Maintenance Malaysia Sdn. Bhd. (“BMM”), its wholly-owned base maintenance facility located at Sultan Abdul Aziz Shah Airport, Subang.

The ceremony will be officiated by Yang Berhormat Tuan Sim Tze Tzin, Malaysia’s Deputy Minister of Investment, Trade and Industry, and attended by representatives from the Federal Government of Malaysia, Selangor State Government, civil aviation authorities, industry agencies, customers, partners and employees.

BMM is part of SIAEC’s regional base maintenance network, providing additional capacity to supplement hangars in Singapore and the Philippines, to support both widebody and narrowbody aircraft maintenance, repair and overhaul (“MRO”) of current and next-generation aircraft across Asia-Pacific and beyond. BMM’s two-hangar facility, which can accommodate up to six concurrent aircraft checks, enhances SIAEC’s operating resilience and provides customers with greater flexibility in meeting their MRO requirements.

The opening of BMM also reflects SIAEC’s confidence in Malaysia as an important aerospace location. Malaysia offers a strong aviation heritage, strategic location, established infrastructure, and a growing pool of skilled aerospace talent. Subang, in particular, continues to play a key role in Malaysia’s aviation and aerospace ecosystem.

Mr Chin Yau Seng, Chief Executive Officer of SIAEC, said: “BMM is a strategic investment for SIAEC to drive sustainable long-term growth. Together with SIAEC’s three other joint venture companies in Malaysia, comprising Asia Pacific Aircraft Component Services, Eaton Aero Services and Pos Aviation Engineering Services, BMM enhances our ability to support customers and provides an important platform for us to grow our presence in Malaysia. We see strong potential in Malaysia’s aerospace sector, particularly in talent development, technical capability and long-term industry growth.”

BMM obtained the necessary regulatory approvals for the first of its two hangars and had performed its first A350 aircraft check in November 2025. The successful completion of aircraft checks for Singapore Airlines have been important milestones in demonstrating BMM’s operational readiness and capabilities.

Mr Foo Kean Shuh, Chairman of BMM, said: "Today marks an important milestone for BMM. We are grateful for the support of the Government of Malaysia, the Selangor State Government, our regulators, customers, partners and employees. BMM is committed to building a trusted and competitive base maintenance hub within the SIAEC Group, serving customers to high standards of safety, quality and reliability."

The establishment of BMM supports the continued development of Malaysia's aerospace ecosystem by creating skilled employment, developing local technical capability, and providing career pathways for aircraft technicians, licensed aircraft engineers, maintenance planners, quality and safety professionals. SIAEC will continue to support BMM through the sharing of technical expertise, operational experience, governance, training, systems and customer support.
