SIA Engineering signs MOU for line maintenance joint venture with Cebu Pacific Air

• SIAEC's first foray into the MRO market in the Philippines, its third line maintenance joint venture outside Singapore

SINGAPORE, 23 December 2004 – Mainboard-listed **SIA Engineering Company Limited** ("SIAEC") today announced that it has signed a Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) with Cebu Pacific Air ("CEB") to set up a joint venture to provide line maintenance, technical ramp handling services and light maintenance checks at thirteen airports in the Philippines.

The yet-to-be-named joint venture, in which SIAEC will hold 51% stake and CEB the remaining 49%, will be SIAEC's third line maintenance joint venture outside Singapore, besides Pan Asia Pacific Aviation Services in Hong Kong and PT Jas Aero Engineering Services in Indonesia.

CEB is the second largest airline in the Philippines, operating domestic flights to and from 13 cities in the country and international flights from Manila and Cebu currently to Hong Kong and Seoul.

Said Mr William Tan, Chief Executive Officer of SIAEC: "Our first foray into the Philippines will give us an opportunity to offer our experience and expertise in aircraft certifications through this partnership with Cebu Pacific. Besides line maintenance, the joint venture will also offer light maintenance, such as "A" checks to airline customers in various airports in the Philippines."

President and Chief Executive Officer of CEB, Mr Lance Gokongwei said: "We are in the midst of renewing our fleet of 15 DC-9s and B757s with new-generation A320 family. SIAEC's comprehensive experience in handling these aircraft will add further value to the joint venture by offering a high level of technical service and despatch reliability to its customers."

Following the signing of the MOU, SIA Engineering Company and Cebu Pacific Air will work on the details of the joint venture agreement.
